CONDITIONS OF PLAY/ INFORMATION SHEET

PLAY COMMENCES: 9.30 am

25 SHOTS UP (shots above 25 should not be counted) - 4 bowls per player.

Senior entries must be 60 years or older as at 5 October 2024 and have not entered into Bowls NSW State Women's Singles or Bowls NSW Open Reserve Singles.

Play will be a knock-out principal each day until a District winner is found. It may be necessary to play 2 games on the one day. To avoid a penalty defeated players must be available to act as a marker in the next round if required. Players will not be permitted to visit the head until after their third bowl.

All entrants must remain a member of the Club from which the entry was received. Conducted under the Laws of the Sport of Bowls.

WBNSW Smoke Free Green Policy applies. Smokers must be a minimum of 4 metres & downwind from other persons on the green or surrounds.

WBNSW Temperature/Humidity Index Chart applies.

An open draw for Regional winners will be made by Women's Bowls NSW.

Clubs where matches are to be played must provide an Umpire.
